

Smoking Policy

Poacher has always had a restrictive smoking policy where smoking has been positively discouraged. The smoking policy for Poacher 2008 has to include current government legislation.

Smoking in Sub-Camps

Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the Sub-Camps except in the designated smoking areas. These smoking areas will be decided by each Sub-Camp on an individual basis.

Smoking is not allowed in personal tents, as this causes the additional risk of personal injury as well as a threat to Poacher 2008 as a whole.

Smoking on the Main Site (Public Areas)

Smoking is only allowed in two designated areas: one close to the Junior Staff bar, the other between the exhibition hall and the main bar lounge. No smoking is allowed in or adjacent to any building or marquee in the main areas of the site, particularly where there may be a large presence of young people.

People wishing to smoke must do so only in designated areas; smoking whilst walking around Poacher is not allowed.

Smoking is not allowed in toilets or in shower areas.

General Conduct

The smoking areas will be equipped with receptacles for the containment of smoking materials and all users of these areas are to ensure that they correctly used and all burning materials are correctly extinguished, before leaving the area.
