

Travel and Transport

Travel Arrangements

By coach, minibus or car

The site will be clearly signposted from all major routes. Entry for groups will be through the A1500 Tillbridge Lane Gate ONLY (There will be no entry onto the Lincolnshire Show ground for groups through the main entrance on the A15)

By train or bus

Local stations are located in Lincoln city centre. Groups are encouraged to arrange their own transfer to the Lincolnshire Showground. If you require assistance with transferring from a local station to the Showground, please contact the Poacher Secretary as soon as possible.

By plane

The nearest airport is Humberside International Airport. Groups are encouraged to arrange their own transfer to the Lincolnshire Showground. If you require assistance with transferring from a local station to the Showground, please contact the Poacher Secretary as soon as possible.

Any UK groups who may be able to help with the transport of other groups from local stations and/or airports with minibuses or coaches are encouraged to contact the Poacher Secretary as soon as possible.

Arrival

Arrival times will be staggered to allow the free-flow of vehicles on site for unloading and groups are asked to adhere to these times. On arrival, groups will be directed to their Sub-Camp HQ, who will register the group onto site and allocate the group's camping area. The Group Leader should then go to the Administration Centre to collect the group's camp booklets, neckers and activity passports.

Uniform

All groups (including leaders) should wear uniform to arrive and depart from Poacher 2008. Scouts and Guides should also wear uniform for off-site activities and trips unless they have been specifically advised not to.

Vehicles

During the Arrival and Departure periods a one way system will operate around the Lincolnshire Showground. Between midnight on Saturday 26th July and 7.00am on Saturday 2nd August no vehicles will be allowed on site (except for emergency and service vehicles). During Poacher 2008 all vehicles should be parked in the Car Park outside the main gate. Cars should be parked to ensure the maximum economy of space and also to keep the cars under the watchful eye of the lighting system and CCTV system that will be installed for the camp.

Groups with box trailers may use them in their camping area as food stores etc for the week. Open trailers may be parked along the side of the police

compound within the Showground, and may be secured using group's own padlocks and chains.
