All members of the Scout and Guide organisations world-wide, aged 10 to 16 years on the 26 July 2008 are welcome to attend and join in the activities.

### Cost

### Insurance

Each group is responsible for its own personal and equipment insurance. International visitors must arrange their own travel and medical insurance.

### Health & Safety

Fire and Security cover throughout the camp. A fully staffed medical centre and First Aider on each Sub Camp.

### Equipment

Bring your own cooking and camping equipment to suit all weathers. All cooking must be on gas stoves (*open fires are not permitted*). Bottled gas for sale on site. Flush toilets on each sub camp, but bring your own washing facilities.

## Activities and Entertainment
